

The convertible was imported into Australia in 1990 and converted to right hand drive. I purchased the car in 1999 and drove it from Sydney to Brisbane.

Since then it has had the suspension rebuilt, RHD conversion redone, including the dash properly converted. Recent work include rusty floor section replaced by the Ferguson brothers, front seats repaired with new leather sections, dynamat installed and new carpet

Engine and transmission are to be restored in the next few months and some additional work will be done to make the RHD conversion more presentable.


